### About the Grammar Workshop

ESL Kingdom's Grammar Workshop has been designed to both introduce and review grammar concepts for intermediate level learners. Each lesson includes an explanation of each grammar point, an outline of its usage, examples demonstrating how the grammar point is used and of course loads of practical exercises - including many *About You* sections – to help learners get to grips with using each grammar point.

### Teaching Tips

Learners often look at grammar as a tiresome exercise. So, to help motivate your learners, it helps to facilitate peer-to-peer interaction between them.

- When an exercise requires a learner to complete a statement and/or question, randomly choose someone to complete the first question. When they have completed the task, have that learner choose who goes next and so on until everyone has had a turn.
- When an exercise requires a learner to answer a question or make the question from the answer, randomly choose who goes first. Then have your learners complete the exercise by asking and/or answering the questions among themselves.
- So learners complete each lesson with more than one skill-set - and therefore have a chance to reinforce their understanding of the material - have them first complete the exercises orally in class before they write the answers; writing can possibly be done for homework.
